CHASE PARK PLAZA REVEALS NEW EXECUTIVE SUITES

Executive Suites provide new take on extended accommodations in St. Louis

ST. LOUIS (June 2, 2008) – The Executive Suites of The Chase Park Plaza officially open this week. The suites are the product of the hotel’s previous corporate apartments redesign, which closed in late 2006 as part of the transformation of the historic Park Plaza Tower.

“The Executive Suites are the first products of the metamorphosis that has been taking place in the Park Plaza Tower during the past 13 months,” said Marcia Smith Niedringhaus, developer of The Chase Park Plaza. “We’re very excited to welcome guests, both familiar and new, to a new standard in corporate and temporary housing.”

The 51 Executive Suites are housed on floors six through eight of The Park Plaza Tower.

Amenities include:

- Covered garage parking;
- Pool and patio privileges;
- Designer furnishings;
- Deluxe housewares;
- Complimentary use of Santé Fitness and Wellness;
- Paid utilities;
- High speed Internet access; and
- Weekly housekeeping service.

Each unit is fully furnished with:

- Full-size refrigerator;

- Marble stone baths.

Lease terms for the suites start with a minimum 30-day agreement. The monthly pricing ranges from \$2,000 to \$4,000, with one-bedroom floor plans of 500 square feet to more than 1,000 square feet.

“Our Executive Suites continue the tradition of the Chase Park Plaza as the marquee location for extended accommodations in St. Louis,” said Smith Niedringhaus. “Guests enjoy all of the services of our world-class hotel, while enjoying cultural attractions that are a few footsteps away—Forest Park, the shops and dining of the Central West End—not to mention the services, cinema and four restaurants inside the hotel.”

Construction in the 86-year-old Park Plaza Tower is nearing completion, with the first homes in [The Private Residences](#) slated to open in August. These residences will be the first and only homes in St. Louis to combine the services and amenities of a world-class hotel with high-rise living. With move-ins starting this summer, The Private Residences at The Chase Park Plaza are already 60 percent sold.
